Process: How we got here

- Four public meetings throughout
 California Feb through April 2016
- 200 people and over 40 counties
- Draft recommendations June 2016
 - Received verbal and written public comments on draft recommendations



Changes to Recommendations

4 substantive changes

Several clarifying changes



Substantive Changes

New recommendations:

- Ensure consistency in demographic reporting requirements
- Evolve towards disaggregated demographic data
- Partner with counties to explore the efficacy of strategies for measuring Access and Linkage to Treatment and Duration of Untreated Mental Illness



Substantive Changes (cont.)

- Align reporting due dates with county budgetary process.
 - ✓ Initial Annual Report: no change Implementation plan due 12/30/17
 - Align subsequent reports with county process



Clarifying Changes

- Consolidate challenges #1 and #2
- Include representatives of unserved and underserved communities in the learning collaboratives
- Specify need for training on how to use the Toolkits
- Broaden discussion of the unique needs of very small counties
- Specify protected health information laws



Next Steps

- After public comment Subcommittee votes on whether to submit the recommendations for full OAC consideration
- If approved today, OAC will consider the issue at its August 25, 2016 meeting
