

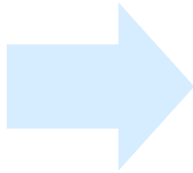

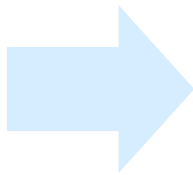

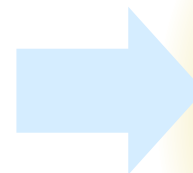
IMPLEMENT PRIORITIES AND DRIVE CHANGE
