Lucero Robles presented an update on SB 803 activities at CalMHSA.

Questions and comments from CFLC on Robles presentation.

Elizabeth Stone: Difference in family member of adult children. Note Parent under 18 and family of adult.

Steve McNally: Disappointed about closed CalMHSA meetings. Has lots of questions for CalMHSA. Please listen to the public. Need to speed up process.

Stacie Hiramoto: Who is CalMHSA working with? Has not heard about listening sessions before today. Unserved communities? Concerned about subject matter experts and unserved communities. Concerned about CalMHSA closed meetings.

Tiffany Carter: Why no formal process to opt in for Peer Certification? How did counties opt in?

Mari Radzik: Peer counselors need support.

Tamplen: Supervision is part of this process. Unique peer services should be honored.

Kylene Hashimoto: What were CalMHSA methods of communicating re: listening sessions? What are best practices for engagement.

Robison: Include recruiting for Peers. Two components: 1) Implementation of Peer Services; 2) Systems integration of peer services.
