1:10 PM	Grantee Presentation re School-Based Mobile Crisis Program: <i>Camden Webb, Clinical Services Director and Kristian Skillman, Clinical Services Coordinator, Solano COE</i> Share how Solano County has utilized MHSSA funding to successfully grow it’s school-based mobile crisis services. It is Solano COE's fourth year utilizing MHSSA funding to provide community school-based mobile crisis services. During this time the need for school-based mobile crisis services was far greater than initially predicted and due to the success of the services, additional schools have reached out and expressed a desire to have access to school-based mobile crisis services. Solano will present lessons learned as well as how to best partner with and serve the community's diverse needs.
