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Section: 158 Item: 4560-101-3085

Provision 2. (a)-(d)

\$5,000,000 shall be available for encumbrance or expenditure until June 30, 2023, to support a peer social media network project for children and youth, with an emphasis on students in kindergarten and grades 1 to 12, inclusive, who have experienced bullying, or who are at risk of bullying, based on race, ethnicity, language, or country of origin, or perceived race, ethnicity, or country of origin.

Objectives: The advisory group shall develop a social media program to support children

and youth who have faced bullying, or who are at risk of bullying, based on race, ethnicity, language, or country of origin, or perceived race, ethnicity, or country of

origin, through the delivery of trusted content from licensed therapists,

counselors, or others to support healthy discussion of difficult topics that young people may not feel comfortable discussing with teachers or parents, and ways to support youth to connect with mental health staff, peer providers, or others to

reduce risks associated with bullying and improve youth resiliency when

experiencing bullying.

Contracts: No later than October 31, 2021, the Mental Health Services Oversight and

Accountability Commission shall contract with one or more entities to provide the services and supports as outlined in the social media program developed

through the commission's advisory group.
