### **COMMISSION'S STATUTE**

Establish technical advisory committees, such as a committee of consumers and family members, and a reducing disparities committee focusing on demographic, geographic, and other communities.



### **COMMISSION'S RULES OF PROCEDURE**

A commitment to the perspectives and participation of diverse community members – including those with lived experience, their family, community advocacy orgs, CBHAs – is a significant factor in the Commission's understanding, actions, and recommendations.



### **COMMISSION'S RULES OF PROCEDURE**

May establish one or more committees as necessary to provide technical and professional expertise, to provide guidance, review materials, and make recommendations.



### **CREATION OF THE CFLC AND CLCC**

- Traditionally met quarterly
- 14 public members each
  - O 2 consumers
  - O 2 family members
  - O 2 underserved ethnic and

cultural communities

- Represent diverse populations
- Chaired by Commissioners

# **BHSA Priority Populations**

### **NOTHING ABOUT US WITHOUT US**

To effectively serve these communities, we must fund and partner with people who have lived these realities.

Their insight ensures relevance, equity, and accountability, and without it, we risk building systems that continue to fail the very people they're meant to serve.



# **BHSA Priority Populations**

Adults, older adults, children & youth, with a serious mental illness and/or severe substance use disorder who:

- Are chronically homeless or experiencing homelessness or are at risk of homelessness.
- Are in, or are at risk of being in, the justice system.
- Are reentering the community from prison, jail, or youth correctional facility.
- Are at risk of conservatorship.
- Are in the child welfare system.
- Are at risk of institutionalization.





# Proposal: Create a Client, Family, and Community Inclusion, Lived Experience, and Diversity Advisory Committee



Builds on the work and feedback of CFLC and CLCC



Responds directly to statutory authority, Commission values, and BHSA priority populations



Designed to center lived experience in all Commission decision-making





# Proposal: Create a Client, Family, and Community Inclusion, Lived Experience, and Diversity Advisory Committee



Includes broad representation of community members most impacted by behavioral health issues



Supports collaboration, transparency, and accountability through regular meetings and advisory input



Can be the community voice for the development of the Innovation Partnership Fund







2025 Membership: Combine CFLC + CLCC Members and appoint additional members as needed for specific expertise

Begin Meeting September 2025

2026: Formal Membership Recruitment
