

Executive Summary

Request for Expenditure Authorization

The Budget and Fiscal Advisory (BFA) Committee reviewed and approved the request that the Commission approve a contract with Veteran’s High Risk Security Solutions, Inc. for \$139,656 for Fiscal Year 2026-2027. They provide on-site, unarmed, security services for the safety and security of Commission staff, stakeholders, and guests at the Commissions headquarters located at: 1812 9th Street, Sacramento, CA 95811.

Background and Procurement Summary

Veteran’s High Risk Security Solutions, Inc. is a certified SB/DVBE with more than 40 years of combined military, security, and law enforcement experience. They provide unarmed security services at government and public facilities statewide.

The Commission conducted a competitive bid and secured a contract with Veteran’s High Risk Security Solutions, Inc., for trial period of six months. The performance has met or exceeded the requirements of the trial period. They demonstrated understanding of State of California security, safety, and workplace protocols.

The costs for services would be paid from the operations budget for Fiscal Year 2026-27. The term agreement would be Fiscal Year 2026-27.
