



Juvenile Justice Involved Youth

According to the 2021 Juvenile Justice in California report, 19,355 juveniles were arrested, and 31,370 juveniles were referred to county probation departments.

Up to 70% of justice involved youth have a diagnosable mental health condition (e.g., suicidal behavior and co-morbid psychiatric disorders), yet low rates of service use.







Foster Youth

In California, an estimated 60,650 youth are in foster care.

In the 2021 school year, approximately 32,256 foster youth were enrolled in California public schools and up to 80 percent of them have significant mental health issues.

Mental and behavioral health is the largest unmet health need for children and teens in foster care. Through MHSSA funded programs, approximately 21,548 foster students can potentially be reached.
