## Where we started Planning

- 2 years planning with Fresno County Department of Behavioral Health
- Developed a \$111 million budget over 5 years (Ramp Up)
- Established a leadership structure
- Formed Committees
- Defined roles & responsibilities



# Where we started Assessing the needs in Fresno County

- Fresno County is over 6,000 square miles
- Population of over 1 million
- 32 Schools Districts and 3 SELPAs
- Low mental health penetration rates
  - Both Rural and Urban
- High Medi-Cal Population
- High Poverty Rates
- Health Index Rating
  - 45 out of 53 counties

- 5-year phased rollout
  - Hub and Spoke Model
- Onboarding districts/schools

  - Assess districts who are ready

### **Evaluation & Quality Management**

- Data collection procedures
- Measuring program performance
  - CANS, Pre-post outcome questionnaire
  - School attendance, expulsion & suspension rates
  - Penetration rates by zip code
- School Satisfaction Surveys
  - Number of referrals per year
  - How many are accessing services
  - Length of time from referrals to treatment/psychiatrist
- Outcomes reporting
  - To Department of Behavioral Health
