1. **Decision-Making Framework:** How could the decision-making framework outlined in the Commission's Strategic Plan be used to enhance the Commission's selection of priorities and project design?
2. **Community Mental Health Needs:** What are the most critical mental health needs in your community, and what best practices can address those needs?
3. **Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion:** How can the Commission effectively promote DEI approaches within the mental health system?
4. **Partnerships:** What steps can the Commission take to facilitate partnerships between consumers, community organizations, and service providers?
5. **Capacity Building:** How can the Commission improve its capabilities (policy research, advocacy, grants, technical assistance, innovation support, and evaluation) to drive transformative change?
6. **Substance Use Disorder Integration:** How can the Commission best support the integration of substance use disorder services into its work?
7. **Behavioral Health Index:** Consider the development of a behavioral health index to track key indicators by county, including negative outcomes and benchmarks for peer counties, states, and nations.
8. **Public Trust and Ownership:** What strategies should the Commission employ to build public trust and ownership in the mental health system?
