● Indirect Services

- Staff assigned to OC Dependents based on Social Services Agency (SSA) Programs/Social Workers
- OC Dependents in Out-of-Home Care:
 - Educational Progress Reports (EPRs)
 - Education Teaming
 - Coordination of Services
 - Transitions
- OC Dependents under Family Maintenance:
 - Case Consultation
 - Connection to Services & Supports

● Direct Services

- Staff assigned to Short-Term Residential Therapeutic Programs (STRTP's) & 7 OC School Districts
- Service Goals:
 - Reengagement
 - Learning Recovery
 - Postsecondary Preparation and Matriculation

Educational Progress Reports (EPRs)

Provide EPRs for Jurisdictional Disposition Court Hearing and 6-month Status Review Hearings

Request Current School Records from LEAs

Educational Assessment of School Records

Collaborate with LEAs to Confirm Appropriate Support Services

Complete Education Progress Report

Share with SW/PO for Court Report

Court Liaison for Education

- Strong collaborative relationship with the OC Juvenile Court
- Provides information, consult, and connections to the Court as requested
- Participates in Court-led Committees & Protocol Development

Collaborative Courts Program (CCP)

- G.R.A.C.E. Court
 - Generating Resources to Abolish Child Exploitation
- Teen Court
 - Youth in foster care identified as having some of the highest level of needs
- Crossover Youth Court
 - Youth dually adjudicated in child welfare & juvenile justice systems
