




Purpose of MHSSA Data Collection and Reporting

- The purpose of the MHSSA evaluation is ultimately program improvement, service enhancement.
- The Commission is required to collect data and provide a report to the legislature on these data.




Update on MHSSA Data Submissions

- First data submission was February 2022.
- Received MHSSA data from Round 1 grantees:
 - 16 out of 18 Phase 1 grantees
 - 4 out of 19 Phase 2 grantees




Round 1 MHSSA Grants Data Collection Guide

- Developed by MHSSA Data Workgroup comprised of grantees.
- Designed purposefully to be broad and comprehensive.




Round 1 MHSSA Grants Data Collection Guide

- Revised to include aggregate data for large group interventions and training.
- Individual reporting tool includes a new variable to capture date of service.



Round 2 MHSSA Grants Data Reporting Tool


- Tool developed for federal reporting requirements.
- Commission staff are in the process of developing FAQs to answer questions we have received from grantees.



MHSSA Data Submission

All Grantees:


- Use Citrix ShareFile for submitting data.
- Each grantee designates their user(s) and has their own secure folder.
- Data can be in an Excel spreadsheet or CSV text file.



MHSSA Data Submission


<u>Due dates</u>:

- Round 1 grantees (first 38 grantees)
 - Reporting biannually
 - Next due date: August 31, 2022
- Round 2 grantees (new grantees)
 - Reporting quarterly
 - First due date: July 8, 2022
