1	General	For purposes of this RFP and contract, do you consider members of the advisory board (high level advisors) as volunteers?	There is no requirement for volunteers in RFP I-I_003.
2	General	Similarly, for purposes of this RFP and contract, do you consider members of the advisory board as administrative staff?	There is no requirement for administrative staff in RFP I-R_003.
3	General	Do you prefer that we answer the questions directly inside the chart/table as shown in the RFP, in order words, should we answer questions directly in attachment 8 (workplan)? Or can we submit a structured powerpoint or word document with answers (and attach all the required documents)?	The Commission prefers that all proposers use the Attachments. The Attachments are provided to ensure Proposers respond to all requirements and provide clear information. Any deviations from using the Attachments are done at the risk of the Proposer.
4	General	Will the state-level sponsor manage/track the budget and costs for local-level contractors in addition to training and advocacy?
