


## Assessing Suicide Risk Factors

#### Methods

- Suicide Consolidated Risk Assessment Profile Form (Courtesy of Washington County, OR Public Health)
- Extracted data and information from coroner reports for suicide deaths from 2013-2018 (December 2018-January 2019)
- Entered data into Excel, matched each form with electronic death certificate.
- Data analysis with EpiInfo 7.0

### Findings: Risk Factor Analysis by Age

#### AGE 49 & UNDER



Other Substance use problems (not alcohol)

38.9% of suicide deaths reviewed

Intimate Partner problems

28.9% of suicide deaths reviewed



AGE 50+



Physical health problem

53.5% of suicide deaths reviewed

Financial problems
18.8% of suicide deaths
reviewed



### Findings: Risk Factor Analysis by Race/Ethnicity

### WHITE NON-HISPANIC

Physical health problem
42.4% of suicide
deaths reviewed





Social isolation
42.4% of suicide
deaths reviewed

Suicidal thoughts or plans at any time

46.8% of suicide deaths reviewed



# ALL OTHER RACES/ETHNICITY



Family relationship stress
60.6% of suicide deaths reviewed



Eviction, loss of home or homeless 21.2% of suicide deaths reviewed
