



Introducing the MHSSA Evaluation Planning Youth Advisory Group

- Purpose: Involve youth partners in decision-making related to the evaluation plan for MHSSA
- Through their participation, youth will
 - learn about MHSSA and the steps of evaluation;
 - practice leadership, teamwork, communication, problem-solving, and shared decision-making with other youths and adults; and
 - have opportunities to speak to leaders across the state of California.





YAG Make-Up

- 15 youths ages 14 to 19
 - 11 women/girls, 2 men/boys, 2 prefer not to disclose gender, 4 LGBTQ youths
- White, Asian or Asian American, Black or African American, and Hispanic or Latinx
- 5 speak a language other than English at home
